

## The Main Types of Apples in Aomori

### Sekai-ichi



In size, at 500-1,000g this is certainly the world's largest apple, as its name indicates. The fruit is somewhat hard. It has a fine texture and plentiful juice. This tasty apple is sweet but slightly tart and is high in fragrance. A variety born in Aomori, the name "Sekai-ichi" means number one in the world.

### Mutsu(Crispin)



This is a large apple. It is not unusual for the fruit to exceed 400-600g in size. The skin is colored with a pleasing pink. It is slightly tart, and is a highly suitable variety for processing, such as cooking. It also has plentiful juice, an excellent flavor for eating, and a high fragrance.

A variety originating in Aomori, the "Mutsu" takes its name from the traditional name of Aomori.

### Jona-Gold



About 300g in size, this apple's skin has a yellowish base with reddish stripes. The fruit is white in color and fairly fine in texture. It has a good balance between sweetness and tartness.

### Fuji



With fruit about 300-500g in size, the skin of the Fuji is colored with scarlet stripes. The fruit is yellowish-white with plentiful juice. It is strongly sweet and also has fragrance, making it an extremely delicious apple. The Fuji makes up about half of all the apples produced in Japan, and is the variety most representative of Japan in both name as well as in fact. This variety originated in the Fujisaki-machi of Aomori, and was named "Fuji" so that it would become NO.1, like Mt. Fuji.

### Kinsei

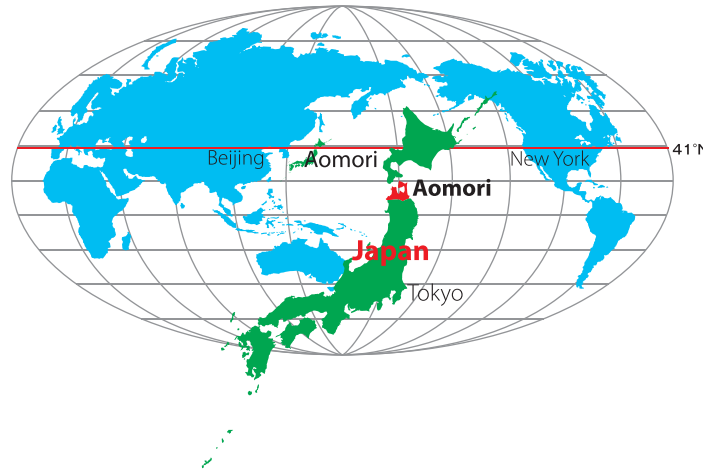


This yellowish-green apple has fruits about 300-400g in size. The fruit is yellowish-white and somewhat hard, and has plentiful juice. The flavor is strongly sweet, making this a densely flavorful, delicious apple. This variety originates in Aomori. Its name, "Kinsei," means the planet Venus.

### Ohrin



An apple 250-300g in size, the Ohrin's skin is yellowish-green in color. With plentiful juice, its fruit is yellowish-white and slightly hard. Sweet yet tart, this tasty apple also has a high fragrance. The "Oh" of "Ohrin" means king.



Aomori Prefecture is home to the famous "Aomori Apple." It is the northernmost prefecture on the mainland of Japan. Aomori is surrounded by the ocean on three sides, is rich with green nature, and has four beautiful distinct seasons.
